

Red Wattlebird *Anthochaera carunculata*

When to look:

Year round. Breeding season is July to December

Grey-brown plumage on body with prominent white streaks

Fleshy red wattle (skin flap) on the side of the neck

Yellow belly

Long tail with white-tipped feathers

Similar species:

Spiny-cheeked honeyeater: beak is red with a black tip. Eye has a grey-blue ring around it.
