

Motorbike Frog *Litoria moorei*

When to look:
September to April

Toes are partially webbed

A dark stripe runs from its snout and over its eyes to its forearm

Similar species:

Similar species *Litoria cyclorhyncha*: doesn't have the blue-green colour in its groin; instead it is replaced by bold black and white spots.

The end of its fingers and toes have obvious discs

It has a green back with gold mottling (after basking in the sun) but can be almost dark brown in colder conditions

Tip: Listen for the call near permanent water bodies that sounds like a long and low growl followed by a series of low growls
