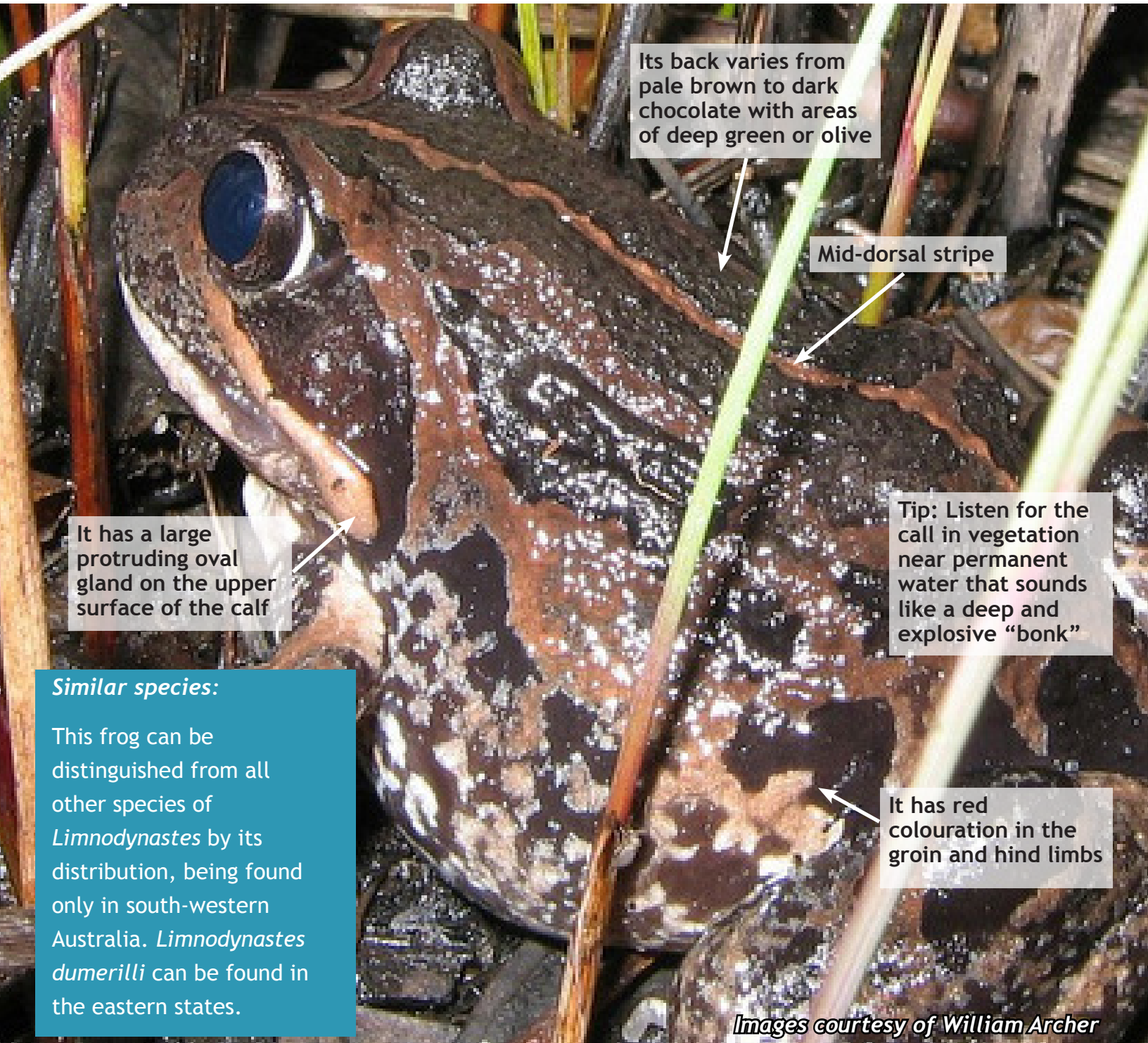


Western Banjo or Pobblebonk Frog *Limnodynastes dorsalis*

When to look:
June to November



Its back varies from pale brown to dark chocolate with areas of deep green or olive

Mid-dorsal stripe

It has a large protruding oval gland on the upper surface of the calf

Tip: Listen for the call in vegetation near permanent water that sounds like a deep and explosive “bonk”

Similar species:

This frog can be distinguished from all other species of *Limnodynastes* by its distribution, being found only in south-western Australia. *Limnodynastes dumerilli* can be found in the eastern states.

It has red colouration in the groin and hind limbs
