

BIRD field guide

Fan-tailed Cuckoo Cacomantis flabelliformis

When to look:

Breeds July-Jan; inland autumn migration



Tail slim, infrequently fanned, feathers wavily notched white on both edges

Yellow eye-ring Slate-grey above, throat and upperbreast pale to cinnamon-buff

Voice: sad, leisurely, downward trill

Similar species:

Brush Cuckoo: plainer; eye-ring and feet grey.
Juvenile's upperpart patterns more variegated than juvenile Fan-tailed Cuckoo. Chestnut-breasted Cuckoo darker; difference range and calls.
