

White-browed Scrubwren *Sericornis frontalis*

When to look:

Year round. Usually breeds
June to December.

Male:

Blackish mask; cream eye; white eyebrow and bold curving silver-white whisker-mark; rufous rump; variable dark tail band.

Female:

Duller. Whisker-mark browner

Similar species:

Similar species: Tasmanian, Tropical Scrubwrens; thornbills. Keep an eye out for the distinct white-brow and curving silver-white whisker-mark of the White-browed Scrubwren.
