

Yellow-faced Honeyeater

Lichenostomus chrysops

When to look:
June to March

Slightly down-
curved bill

Curving yellow streak
back from bill below
eye that splits a
narrow, black “mask”.
Slight yellowish mark
behind eye

Paler below with
lighter streaks

Some brown
streaking on head.
Dark gre-brown
above

Voice: brisk
‘chickup; clear,
descending ‘calip,
calip’; flight call:
‘dep’

Similar species:

Eungella, Bridled, Singing
Honeyeaters. Eungella has
whitish streak, not yellow;
Bridled has black bill with
yellow base and white
scalloping behind eye.
