

Corkwood or Bootlace Oak *Hakea lorea*

When to look:
April to September

Small tree that
grows up to 6
m in height



Shiny, dark green, needle-
like leaves up to 40 cm in
length

Bright orange to
dull lemon flowers

Deeply fissured,
corky and rough bark



Woody and slightly curved
seed pods that are 3.5 cm
across

Similar species:

Hakea chordophylla: has
longer, thicker striated
leaves with distinctive
yellow petioles.
