

PLANT field guide

Silky Oak Grevillea robusta



Silvery green and fern-like leaves that are 10-34 cm in length

Smooth, oval seed pods that turn dark brown when mature

When to look:

September to January, flowers appear in spring, mature seed pods appear December-Jaanuary

Evergreen tree that grows 8-40 m in height

Similar species:

The Silky Oak is a very distinct tree and unlikely to be confused with <u>anything else</u>.

Golden yellow to orange flowers
