

REPTILE *field guide*

Grey/brown stripe

behind eye to ear

Eastern Bearded Dragon Pogona barbata

When to look:

Spring time for mating, Aug to Dec for hatchlings

Similar species:

The Inland Bearded Dragon (*P. vitticeps*): similar in appearance to *P. barbata*; however, they mostly reside in inland Australia.

Mottled grey with yellow undertones

Spiny body and tail

Underside is grey with dark circles

Up to 67 cm in length
