

Eastern Yellow Robin *Eopsaltria australis*

When to look:

*Commonly breeds
July to January*

Similar species:

Western Yellow Robin
(*Eopsaltria griseogularis*):
occurs in south-western and
southern Australia, mainly
west of the Eyre Peninsula,
so the range of this species
does not overlap with that
of the Eastern Yellow Robin.

Pale-yellow Robin
(*Tregellasia capito*): smaller
than an Eastern Yellow
Robin, with olive-coloured
upperparts, a pale face and
lighter, pale-yellow
underparts and lacks pale
yellow eyebrow.
